contribute to the well-being of humankind.

Prize The Prize will be awarded to two laureates. Each laureate receives a certificate of merit, a

medal, and a monetary award of 10 million yen.

Ceremony The award ceremony is scheduled to be held in November 2023 at the Keio University School

of Medicine, Shinanomachi Campus, Tokyo, Japan.

Guidelines for Making a Nomination for 2023

Criteria

- · The nominee must have made a breakthrough in medicine and the life sciences, or a related field.
- · The nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to basic and clinical medicine.

Selection

18 selection committee members and around 80 specialists from various fields within and outside Keio University will select laureates through a rigorous review process.

Eligibility

- · Nominees must be currently active in their field of research and be expected to make future contributions to the field.
- · The Keio Medical Science Prize is an international award.


Nomination

- · Individual nominators may make one nomination only.
- There is no limit to the number of nominations that institutions or organizations may make, but academic societies may make only a small number of nominations. In the case of making multiple nominations, nominations are limited to one nominee per research theme.

Nominations for 2023 must reach the Keio University Medical Science Fund Office by March 5, 2023.

- A nomination should be made for one researcher only. We do not accept group nominations.

- Nomination materials will be used exclusively for the selection process and will not be used or disclosed for any other purposes.
- Nominators will be informed of the results in late September after final decisions have been made.
